The school will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection following government guidelines;
- Provide parents with the details of our risk assessment and the measures we have taken on request.
- When organising our bubbles we will try to recognise friendship groups where possible.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions. Ensure additional Behaviour policy guidance with relation COVID 19 is available on the website. As well the expectations outlines in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

Please be informed that social distancing is not something we can guarantee given the age of the primary school children. Reception and Year1 children will not be expected to social distance given their age and learning style.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

Parents must inform school if they wish to take a place for the following week by 12:00 Wednesday at the latest, allowing meal vouchers to be ordered and risk assessments to be completed.

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school;
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- I will support school by teaching my child how to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment via telephone or email;
- I will ensure my child/children wear clean clothes daily (uniform not necessary).
- I will need to read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and 2 emergency contacts details.
- I understand and support school that If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

I will do my best to:

- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;

- Not mix with any other children outside of my bubble in the school;
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
