Dear parents, carers and children,

Firstly, welcome back to those of you who have not been attending our key worker group. It has been a long time away from school but we are looking forward to welcoming children back for their final half term of school this academic year.

Please read the following information carefully. This is in addition to and reinforces the Parental Agreement, which is required to be signed and returned prior to your child attending school, this applies to current children attending as key worker children and vulnerable children as well as the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 returning, from week beginning 22nd June 2020. Children will be informed of the bubble they are in on entry to school. Please be aware that bubble staff may change as unforeseeable circumstances change.

Please note the change of time due to increase in numbers in school and the need for thorough cleaning every evening.

Please note this group does not have consistent staff or children due to the nature of the group and provision.

If you bring a packed lunch everything must be disposable.

Multiple drop offs, parents must leave the premises and re-enter through the appropriate gate

Only one parent may drop off / collect the children from school at any one time

- All children in will be provided with a packed lunch in the Reception/ Year 1/ Year 6 bubbles and those in the key worker group who have booked one. This will not affect families eligible for the voucher scheme.
- NO items are to be brought in to school from home, except a coat. This includes pencil cases, books, food and drinks.
- Uniform is optional, but children must wear clean clothes each day. Following Government guidelines, school reserve the right to send children home who do not adhere to this. Sensible shoes are also required as the children may spend time outdoors.



- High standards of behaviour will, as always, be insisted upon. Social distance rules must always be followed. Failure to follow these instructions may result in children being sent home for everyone's safety within the classroom bubble.
- If your child or a family member has signs of Covid-19 please inform the school office immediately and DO NOT bring your child to school, as stated in the parental agreement. Your child must be tested as all children and staff in their bubble will be sent home until results of a test allow otherwise. For a return to school we will require evidence of a clear test. This will also be the case for staff members.
- If a child or adult within a bubble test positive for Covid-19, everyone in that bubble will be required to remain at home for 14 days.
- Signed Parental Agreements will be required before admitting your child to school. These will be available on arrival to school. Year 6 parents – please ensure you either send the agreement to school prior to Thursday or that the child brings the agreement with them. No signed agreement, unfortunately will mean no admittance on the school premises for the health and safety of everyone.
- Attendance needs to be confirmed to school by Wednesday at 12noon, at the latest, if your child is to attend the following week.

We look forward to seeing you back in school.
