Unfortunately, children and their families will not be able to socialise on the playground together due to social distancing rules.

Please enter via the Chaucer Road entrance. Only a few children at any one time will be on school premises, the staff can wave goodbye and children can collect their ice-cream before exiting via the opposite side of the playground onto Tennyson Road.

Whilst queueing to enter school premises, please ensure you are socially distancing.

It will be lovely to see the children if only for a few minutes.
