

Autumn 2	I can identify multiples and factors up to 12x12	List the first 5 multiples of 8: 8, 16, 24, 32, 40 Find the factors of 40: 1 x 40, 2 x 20, 4 x 10, 5 x 8	1

Spring 1	I can identify prime numbers up to 50	Primes have two factors: themselves and 1. The first 5 primes are: 2, 3, 5, 7 and 11	1
