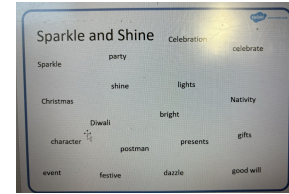
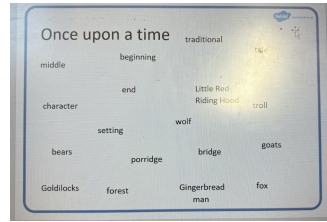


Reception - Knowledge Organiser - Autumn 2 - Once upon a time & Sparkle and Shine

Physical Development



We will be focusing on being creative in the different levels in our travelling movements. The children will be working together showing good listening skills.

Literacy

We will be continuing to use our listening ears to listen to stories and recall the main events. We will be engaging in conversations with our friends and adults. We will be learning Phase 2 sounds and how to use the sounds to read and write letters and CVC words.

Understanding the World

The children will be learning about different celebration such as Diwali and Christmas. They will also be looking at some features of plants and animals identifying similarities and differences.



Expressive Art and Design



We will be making some independent choices in the resources needed to be creative. The children will be experimenting with textures in creations and combine different medias to produce pieces of art.

The children will be using modeling tools to create diva lamps and will be performing in the school Nativity play.
