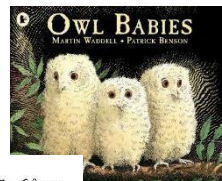
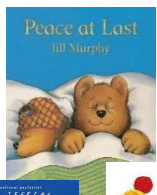
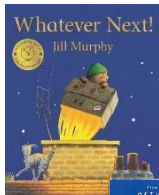


# Reception - Knowledge Organiser - Spring 1- Starry Night

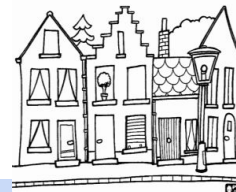

## Physical Development



We will be focusing on overarm and underarm throwing, gymnastic rolls, balancing and jumping.

## Literacy

The children will be continuing to use our listening ears to listen to stories and recall the main events. We will be engaging in conversations with our friends and adults. We will be learning Phase 2/3 sounds and how to use the sounds to read and write letters, CVC words and simple sentences.



## Understanding the World

The children will be learning about the first landing on the moon and significant people. Children will also learn about the features of Earth and Space. Enjoy reading special stories in RE.



## Expressive Art and Design

The children will be making some independent choices in the resources needed to be creative. The children will be experimenting with textures in creations and combine different medias to produce pieces of art.
